

What is Confirmation?

Confirmation is a public response to our Baptism. Meaning it's about commitment - not just during confirmation but as we walk with Christ within our church community. Confirmation is an experience about commitment while making a commitment.

Fall Expectations

- I will participate in at least 10 youth ministry opportunities by Dec.16. These include at least 5 EYC's (Episcopal Youth Community) and 5 Sunday morning formation or EYC's.
- I will sign up and participate in one of the clergy lunches on Oct. 21, Oct. 28, or Nov. 4
- I will turn in my Confirmation form by Advent I (Dec. 2). I will need a mentor that is a St. Paul's church member. If I do not, I understand that the church will help me find one before Advent I.

Spring Expectations

- I will plan on being at all 10 Confirmation classes including the Annual meeting.
- I understand that all the dates for the classes have been given to me in September of 2018
- I understand that I can miss up to 3 classes but will need to email Nick to let him know (not my parents) and will then listen to the online lecture and turn in a one page reflection paper before the next class.
- I understand that if I miss more than 3 classes, I will have to meet with the Rector to discuss how and when I will be able to be confirmed.

Spaghetti dinner

- I understand that I will be participating in the Spaghetti dinner with my mentor on March 24
- I will sign up for at least one Sunday to help sell tickets to the Spaghetti dinner

Confirmation Sunday

- I will be present on Confirmation Sunday for the rehearsal and the 10am service.
