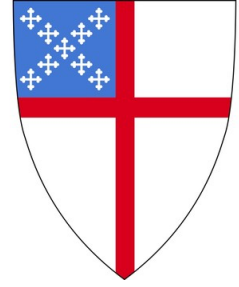


Youth Mentor Reflection

Do you reaffirm your renunciation of evil?

Do you renew your commitment to Jesus Christ?

Since you most likely did not answer the 6 questions on p 302 of the BCP at your baptism, how would you answer the above today? What do these 2 questions mean to you now? How will you work to fulfill your promises to God?

Do you see your confirmation as an ongoing journey, as a recommitment to the promises made at your baptism?

What is the coolest thing about your having been baptized and about your choice to be confirmed? What does it all mean to you?
